

What You Can Recycle in Your Recycling Bin

You Can Recycle	Please Remember...
 <p>Tins and Cans including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food Tins • Sweet/biscuit tins • Metal lids • Drinks Cans 	<p>Rinse tins and cans</p> <p>Tip – labels can be left on</p>
 <p>Glass including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glass bottles • Glass jars 	<p>Rinse bottles and jars</p> <p>Tip – labels can be left on. Jar lids can be kept on or put in the silver bin separately</p>
 <p>All plastic bottles including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drinks bottles/milk/juice bottles • Detergent and fabric conditioner bottles • Cleaning/bleach/toiletry bottles <p>Plastic containers and tray including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Margarine/ice cream tubs/yoghurt pots • Fruit/vegetable punnets • Plastic trays e.g meat/fish/cake trays • Soup/sauce pots, egg boxes • All empty plastic bags/carrier bags/film 	<p>Rinse bottles, trays and containers</p> <p>Tip- Plastic bottles should be squashed and tops replaced, but labels can be left on.</p> <p>Polystyrene, plant pots and hard rigid plastics cannot be recycled</p>
 <p>All empty steel and aluminium aerosols</p>	<p>Remove plastic lids if detachable and put in the recycling bin separately</p> <p>Aerosols containing hazardous liquids or gases are not accepted e.g paint sprays</p>
 <p>All paper including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Newspapers/magazines • Telephone directories/Yellow Pages • Catalogues/brochures • Junk mail/leaflets/Greeting Cards • Envelopes/Shredded paper • Wrapping paper and clean paper bags <p>All cardboard including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cereal boxes/ready meal boxes • Corrugated/Thick cardboard • Egg boxes/kitchen/toilet roll tubes 	<p>Remove plastic wrappers off magazines and put in the recycling bin separately.</p> <p>Greetings cards or wrapping paper with glitter cannot be recycled</p> <p>Please flatten all cardboard</p>
 <p>Cartons including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Milk/juice/smoothie cartons • Fabric conditioner cartons • Soup/chopped tomatoes cartons • Custard cartons 	<p>Rinse cartons</p> <p>Tip – please squash cartons, plastic spouts can be left on</p>
 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean aluminium foil • Clean foil trays 	<p>Rinse foil</p>
